Directions:

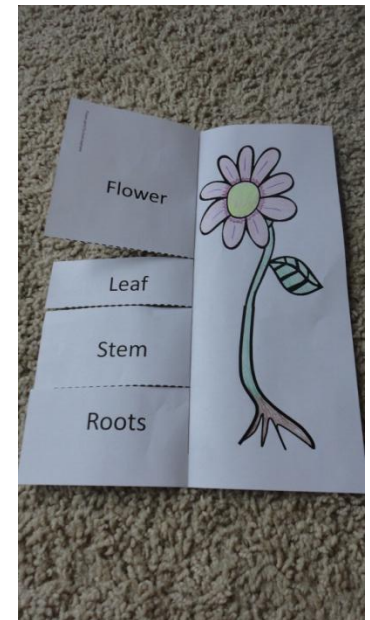
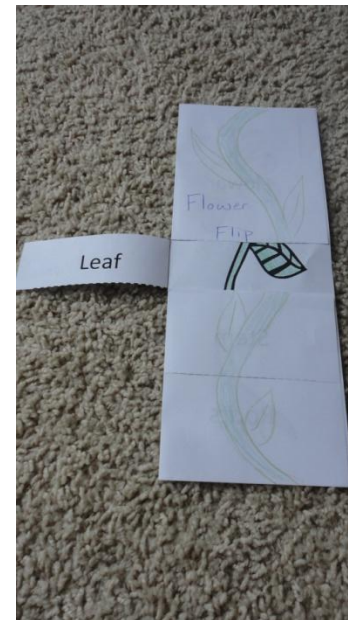
- Print out provided flower sheet.

- Color flower if desired.

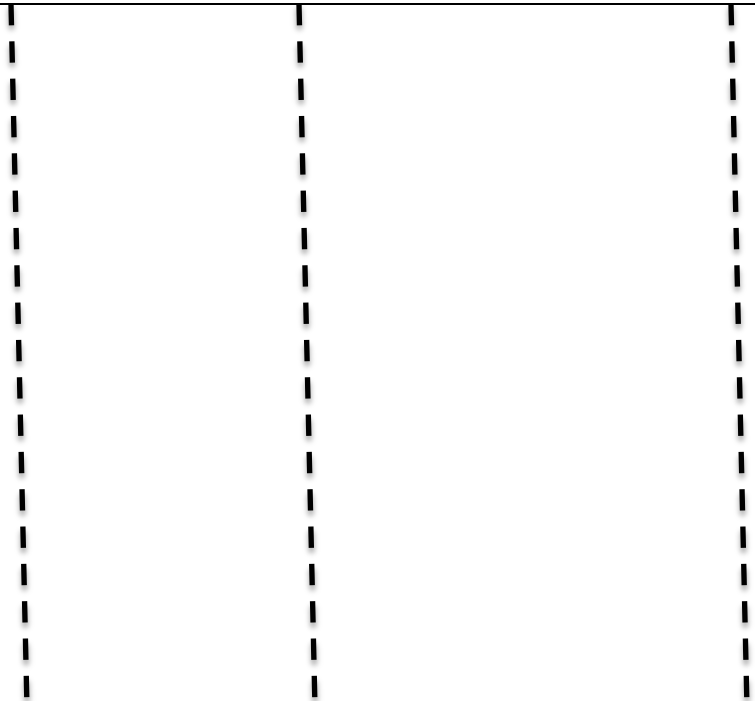
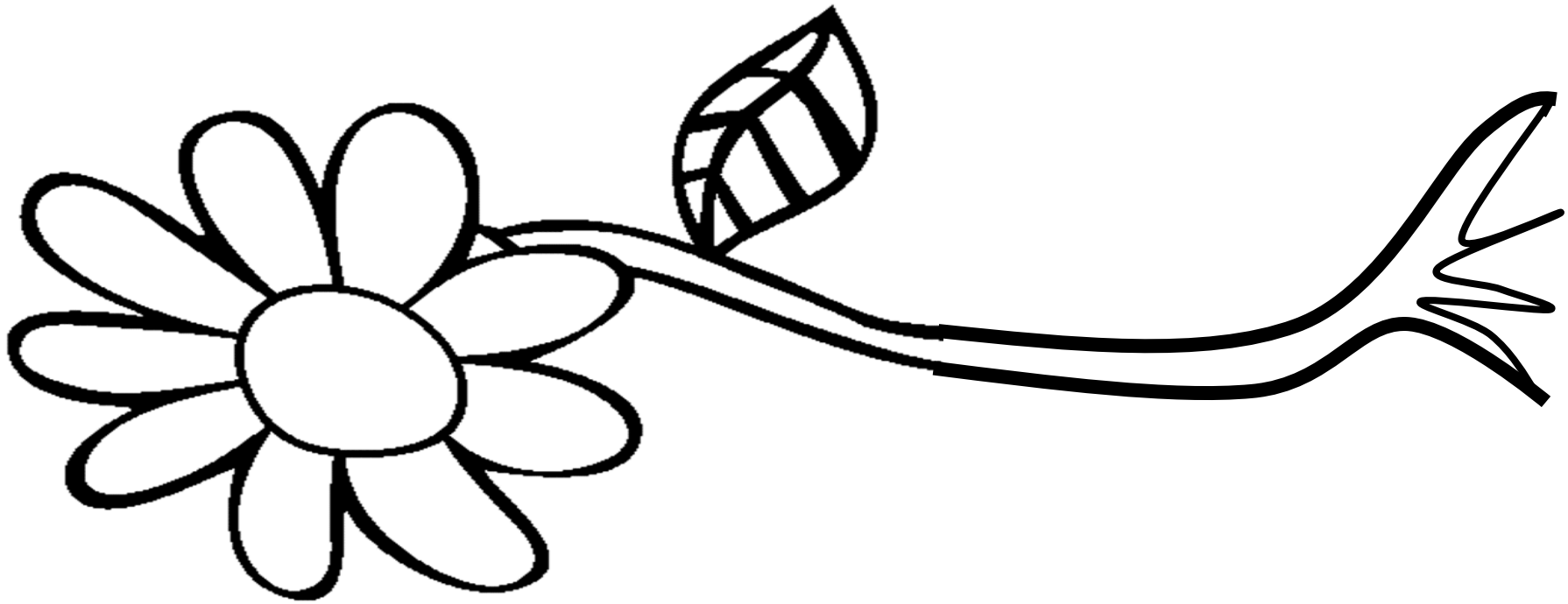
Alternative Activity:

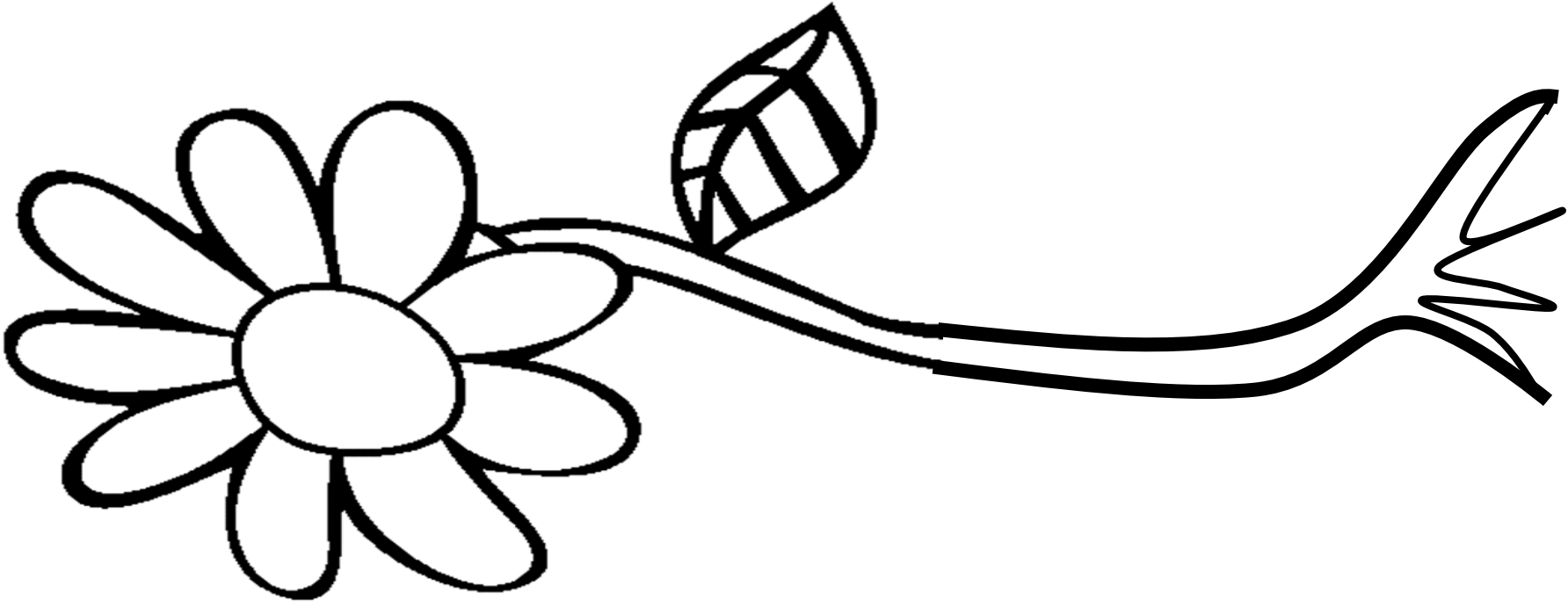
- Use pipe cleaners to build a flower.

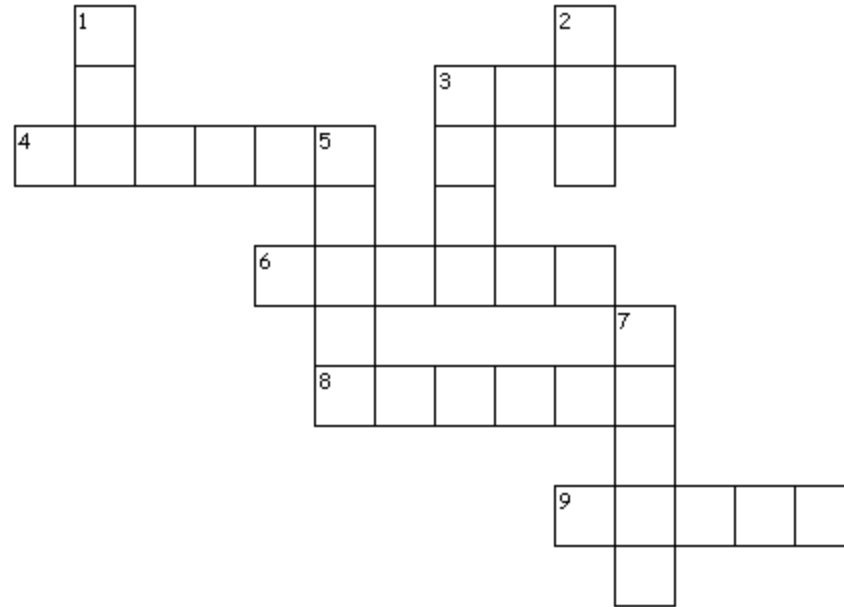

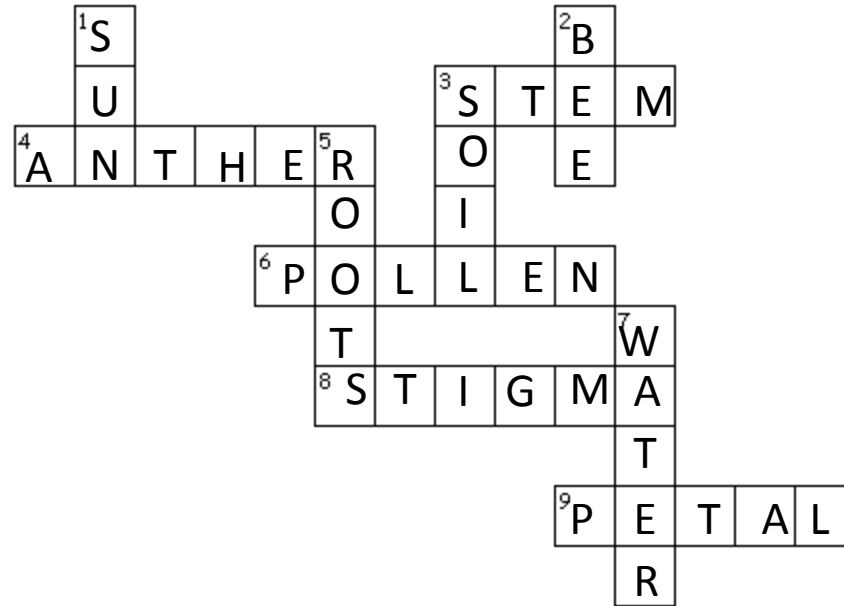
3. The part of the flower that is used for support.

Create-a-Flower (2-5)

This activity focuses on parts of a flower and what a flower needs to survive.

Supplies:

- Paper
- Coloring Utensils
- Pencil

Directions:

- Tell the kids that they have just discovered a new flower!
- They now have to draw their flower and label the main parts (must be similar to a real flower).
- They must also: name the flower, write down what the plant needs to survive, where the plant is found, and any other information they would like to add.
- They can also create a fact sheet for their new plant that can contain pictures, maps, labels, and anything else you may want to require.
